SHOW COMMITTEE: The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries for cause.

ENTRIES: SEPARATE ENTRY NEEDED FOR EACH DAY! Accepted on first come, first served basis, based on (readable) postmark. Post entries (postmarked after closing date) will be accepted on a space available basis with late fee. Once the competition is filled a wait list will be established. Wait list will be maintained through August 18, 2010. Current 2010 RMDS entry form must be used. Proof of memberships and horse registrations must be included with entry. If riding freestyle include a copy of qualifying test. If entry is incomplete, horse/rider combination will be placed on the wait list until required paperwork is received. Numbers required at all times when horse is outside of stall. Entry form required if schooling only.

REFUNDS: Up through closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. Qualifying fees and USEF fee (if horse is not on show grounds) refunded. Stabling fees refunded if cancellation is on or before August 17, 2010. Unless ride can be filled from waitlist, (maintained through Wednesday, August 19) no refunds for any reason, including Acts of God. During competition days no refunds. **Office fee is never refundable.**

AWARDS: First Place trophy & ribbons through 6th place. High Point Awards per division per day minimum. USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal for Classes #107, 207, 307 (The winner must be a USDF GM, PM, or IM member, hold a USEF AA card and earn a minimum 60% score).

STABLING: Permanent 10x10 stalls with mats and full doors or permanent 8x16 stalls with Dutch doors, bedding required but not provided. Shavings available on grounds, place orders in show office. Advance bedding orders with entries will be placed in stalls prior to arrival. **Stabling available on Weds. August 18, 2010.** If needed earlier, contact Heather. If you have a preference of one stall type over another, please note on entry.

ARENAS: Outdoor 20 x 60-meter show arenas, outdoor warm-up arenas; all sand mix footing. Arenas watered and worked throughout show. Show arenas open for schooling Thursday afternoon/evening until show office closes each day.

VET/FARRIER: On Site. Information posted in show office. **EMT:** On-Site EMTS.

CONCESSIONS: Food available on premises. Other concessions/vendors, contact show secretary.
